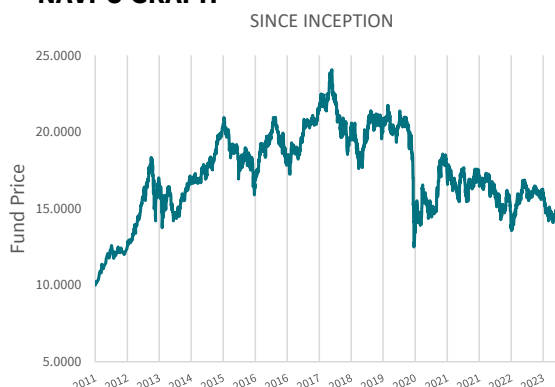

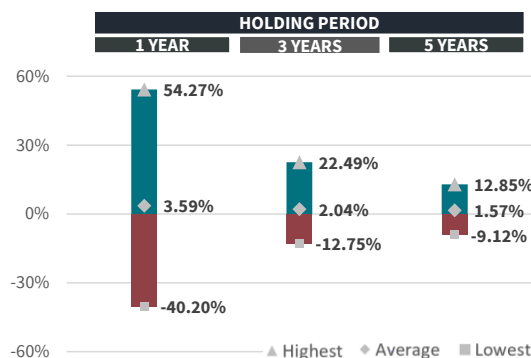

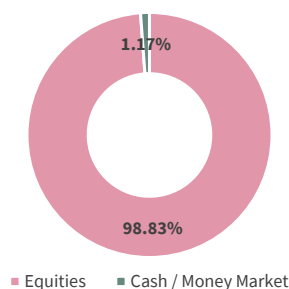
RANGE OF ANNUALIZED RETURNS⁴
