

## MARKET COMMENTARY

The Nasdaq 100 index underperformed the S&P 500 amid geopolitical tensions and sector-specific dynamics. The index's underperformance was mainly due to its overweight exposure to Consumer Discretionary and underweight in Energy sectors. Notable company results included Meta Platforms, which surged on strong earnings driven by higher ad revenues, while Microsoft saw a steep decline following concerns over slowing Azure growth despite beating revenue and earnings expectations. Walmart was added to the index, replacing AstraZeneca. The Fed kept rates unchanged at 3.75%, with market focus on potential policy shifts under new Fed Chair Kevin Warsh, amid rising U.S. Treasury yields and a strengthening Yen. The market outlook remains cautious amid geopolitical risks and evolving monetary policies.
