Medium Risk





## MARKET COMMENTARY

Global equity markets continued to grind higher in January despite the increased volatility due to geopolitical tensions. Most Developed Markets generated positive returns but underperformed their emerging market counterparts. Global bonds retracted for the month due to improving investor risk appetite and country-specific developments. During the period, JP Morgan Asia Pacific Equity was the leading contributor to performance for the period as Emerging Market equities outperformed their developed market peers. Other notable contributors to performance included iShares MSCI Emerging Market Asia ETF, NT AC Asia ex Japan Screened Equity, Federated Hermes Asia ex Japan Equity and Vanguard Pac ex Japan Stock Index. On the month, Amundi Russell 1000 Growth ETF was the main drag to performance weighed down by its exposure to US equities for the period. Since the target fund is USD-denominated, the return of this peso share class fund was slightly affected by a slight movement between the Philippine peso and the US dollar.
