The Fund is a passive equity fund that aims to provide investment returns corresponding to the general performance of the 100 largest and most active non-financial stocks in the US. It achieves this by investing in exchange-traded funds listed globally.

MARKET COMMENTARY

The Nasdaq 100 outperformed the S&P 500 in October, amid a cautious environment following the Fed's rate cut to 4.0% and signals of potential nearterm stability. The market was influenced by a government shutdown that temporarily paused key economic data releases and by Fed Chair Powell's remarks suggesting a December rate decision remains uncertain. Technology giants like Microsoft, Alphabet, Amazon, and Apple delivered strong earnings, boosting overall sector performance, while Tesla and Meta missed expectations. Investor focus is shifting toward upcoming earnings reports and the December Fed meeting amid volatile macro conditions. The market remains sensitive to policy signals, with risks including economic headwinds, geopolitical uncertainties, and sector-specific volatility. Investors are advised to consider the inherent risks of concentration in high-growth sectors.


Volatility measures the degree to which the Fund fluctuates vis-à-vis its average return in a specific period. The lower the number, the more stable the Fund's return is.


NAVPU GRAPH
