
INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE

The Global Equity Income Paying Fund is a unit-linked fund that aims to provide a regular payout to its shareholders by investing in dividendpaying U.S. large-cap equities with quality and growth characteristics.

MARKET COMMENTARY⁹.

The WisdomTree U.S. Quality Dividend Growth Fund (DGRW) gained in August, supported by continued strong Q2 earnings and positive market momentum. Despite some sector-specific fluctuations, such as a dip in NVIDIA's shares, U.S. equities maintained a rally driven by solid earnings growth—expected to reach 11% year-over-year—marking the third consecutive quarter of double-digit growth. DGRW's August outperformance was aided by favorable sector positioning, notably its overweight in energy, which outperformed the broader market, and its underweight in Information Technology, which lagged during the month. Overall, the market remains supported by strong fundamentals, although some caution persists amid mixed sector performances.

Since the target fund is USD-denominated, the return of this peso share class fund was significantly lower than that of its dollar share class as the Philippine peso strengthened against the US dollar.
