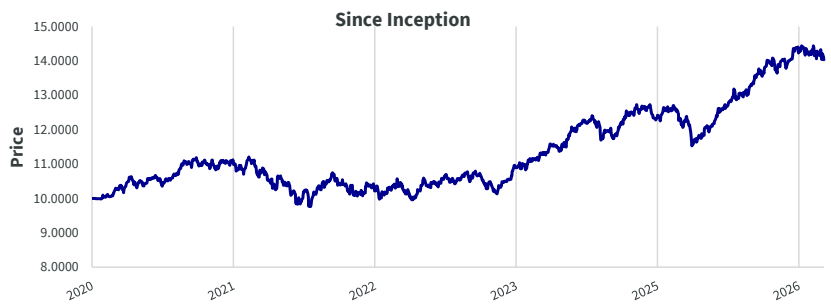

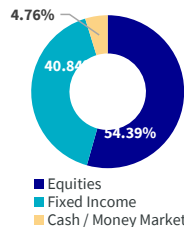
NAVPU GRAPH

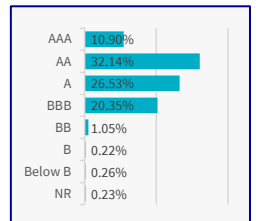

MARKET COMMENTARY

The fund posted negative returns in March as global equity markets declined due to Middle East geopolitical tensions, with developed markets outperforming emerging markets. The global bond market experienced rising yields and falling prices, driven by higher oil prices and inflation expectations. Barings Global High Yield Bond contributed the least to performance, benefiting from its increased cash holdings. Conversely, the iShares MSCI Emerging Market Asia ETF was the leading detractor, impacted by significant declines in Korean and Taiwanese equities during the month. Since the target fund is USD-denominated, the return of this peso share class fund was significantly higher than that of its dollar share class as the Philippine peso weakened against the US dollar.
