MARKET COMMENTARY⁹

The WisdomTree U.S. Quality Dividend Growth Fund underperformed the S&P 500 in December amid mixed economic signals and sector-specific challenges. U.S. inflation showed signs of easing with a 2.7% YoY CPI increase, while labor market indicators reflected softer job growth and a higher unemployment rate, suggesting an uneven economic outlook. Corporate earnings remained robust, with Q3 results showing 13-14% YoY growth, although market reactions were subdued. The fund's underperformance was influenced by its overweight position in Consumer Staples, which was among the worst performing sectors, as well as its underweight allocations to Consumer Discretionary and Health Care, which negatively impacted relative returns. Sector positioning and macroeconomic dynamics played a significant role in shaping the fund's performance during this period.


NAVPU GRAPH
