Medium Risk

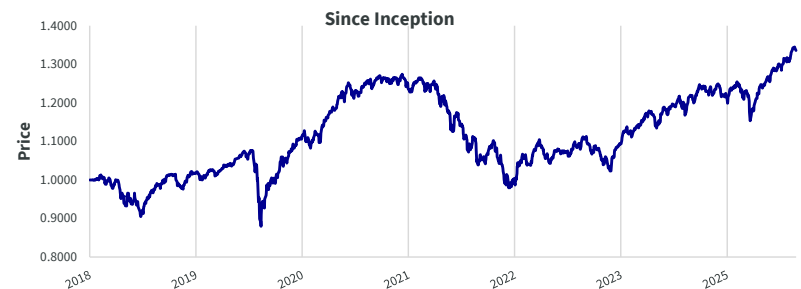

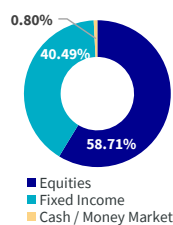

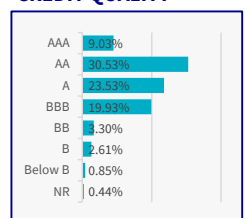

MARKET COMMENTARY

In September, the fund achieved positive returns driven by strength in both equity and bond markets, supported by optimism around a potential Federal Reserve interest rate cut, which boosted most equity indexes. Emerging markets outperformed developed markets, with the iShares MSCI Emerging Market Asia ETF leading contributions. Other notable contributors included NT AC Asia ex Japan, Federated Hermes Asia ex Japan, Amundi Russell 1000 Growth ETF, and BlackRock Advantage US Equity. Bond markets experienced mixed results amid changing economic data and political developments. Conversely, Vanguard Pacific ex-Japan Stock Index lagged behind, mainly due to its exposure to Australian equities. Overall, the fund benefitted from favorable equity performance, particularly in emerging markets.
