INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE

The Fund is an actively-managed fund-of-funds that seeks to provide its investors access to a diversified portfolio of fixed income securities spread across five major regions in the world while maintaining a lower level of portfolio risk.

Fund risk ratings are calculated based on the historical volatility of the fund in order to match the client's risk profile. A risk profile of 2 matches with the conservative investor, indicating a fund with a lowmedium volatility profile (i.e. fixed income, money market).



MARKET COMMENTARY

The fund delivered positive returns in October, driven by strong performance in global bond markets supported by a Federal Reserve rate cut amid a weaker job market. High-yield bonds outperformed investment grade and government bonds, with Neuberger Berman Emerging Market Debt Hard Currency leading the contributions thanks to U.S. treasury rate cuts. Conversely, AXAWF Global High Yield Bonds lagged, primarily due to its regional focus on U.S. high-yield debt. Overall, the period reflected gains across fixed income assets, influenced by monetary policy moves and regional allocations. Since the target fund is USD-denominated, the return of this peso share class fund was significantly higher than that of its dollar share class as the Philippine peso weakened against the US dollar.
